Title: Digital Learning Technologist

Job Summary

To work with the Head of Learning Enhancement and other colleagues in the development of technology enhanced learning, by performing effective system administration on the VLE; investigating issues, collecting and analysing data and implementing corrective action; providing an effective service to staff and student users using initiative and creativity to solve problems relating to the implementation and use of the VLE and other digital learning technologies and advising on the best use of technologies to enhance learning and teaching. The post-holder will work closely with academic and professional service staff and students providing at elbow support and high quality online resources to ensure thorough training in the use of the VLE and related systems is available and accessible across BGU and, where appropriate, its partner colleges. They will support the implementation of strategic learning, teaching and assessment priorities and embedding best pedagogic practice throughout the use of the VLE and associated systems.

Detailed Responsibilities

- Ensure the effective day-to-day running and development of the VLE to enhance learning and teaching across the institution. Provide a professional service at all times in accordance with the aims of the Centre for Enhancement in Learning and Teaching (CELT). Be proactive in engaging others in making the most of the service.
- 2. Work alongside the Head of Learning Enhancement and the Head of CELT to embed enhancements to learning and teaching through implementation of the Learning, Teaching and Assessment Strategy.
- 3. Investigate issues, solve problems and implement corrective action, feeding back to users, providers and or suppliers as appropriate.
- 4. Provide an effective service to staff and students, using initiative and creativity to solve problems relating to use of the VLE and other digital learning technologies using clear written and oral communication.

- 5. Assist colleagues in CELT, academic and professional staff in developing skills, competences and confidences related to the use the VLE and other associated technologies.
- Advise staff on best practice and provide guidance on innovative and appropriate pedagogy and approaches to enhancing the student learning experience.
- 7. Work with academic staff to improve and enhance the use of the VLE and other digital technologies for teaching, learning, and assessment.
- 8. Provide regular support and training for staff and students, including one to one, at elbow support, and small and large group workshops and advice sessions, which may be online or face-to-face.
- 9. Develop and coordinate projects designed to improve and enhance learning, teaching and assessment and administrative practices and student tracking through strategic use of digital technologies.
- 10. Manage pilots of new and existing technologies relating to best practice in learning, teaching and assessment, leading task and finish groups and overseeing appropriate evaluative processes.
- 11. Make creative decisions to produce electronic resources and training materials to support the use of technology across the institution.
- 12. Contribute to the design and development of blended, distance and online programmes
- 13. Conduct regular evaluation of the system, training materials and resources with students and staff. This will involve gathering data of a quantitative and qualitative nature and assisting with the interpretation and presentation of this information, formulating recommendations and providing advice on the implications of the data.
- 14. Liaise with academic teams and CELT to ensure that the role is conducted to support the strategic alignment of CELT across the University.
- 15. Share and model best practice in all aspects of digital learning and pedagogies, identifying these both within BGU and externally
- 16. Maintain an open and approachable demeanour in all dealings with staff and students and will be required to show a concerned and helpful approach at all times: being aware of appropriate sources of support, help and advice for all commonly occurring situations.

- 17. Lead and contribute to groups and committees and report back to CELT as appropriate.
- 18. Attend external events to promote and disseminate the work of CELT and BGU.
- 19. To attend appropriate staff development sessions and participate in the annual appraisal process
- 20. To comply with the University's Health and Safety Welfare Policy, legislation and practice
- 21. To maintain professional standards in relationships, including non-discriminatory practices
- 22. To undertake any other duties that may reasonably be required
- 23. The post-holder must operate within the guidelines, procedures and regulations of the University, including the University's Financial Regulations, Diversity and Equality Policy and other relevant policies
